

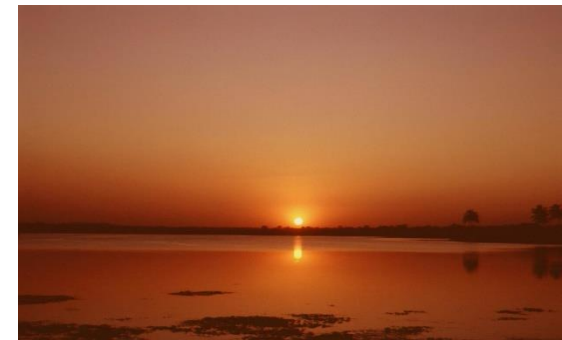
Unkal Lake

6.7 KM

Unkal lake is **beautiful water spot in Hubli & is about 110 years old.**

This lake is spread across 200 acres of land. Centre of the lake is situated the statue of Swami

Vivekananda which is the prime attraction of the lake. It has recreational facilities for children.



Indira Gandhi Glass House

1 KM

Located at the centre of the HDMC gardens, Indira Glass house is a **unique palace made of glass** which was inaugurated by the former Indian Prime Minister, **Smt. Indira Gandhi** and hence called Indira Glass House. The glass house also has expansive lush green lawns and skating ground.



Nrupatunga Betta

4.3 KM

Nrupatunga Betta, nestled on the Unkal Hill in Hubli is **a hill located in Hubli**. It is the highest hill station in the twin city of Hubli-Dharwad and from here one can get a panoramic view of the whole city. Atop the hill, there is a Devi temple where visitors can offer prayers.



Chandramouleshwara Temple

4.3 KM

On the banks of the Unkal lake beside the Nrupatunga Hills in the Hubli-Dharwad city is a 900-year-old temple of Chandramouleshwara. Lord Shiva is the deity of the temple. The temple has marvelous sculptures that attract any art lover. Due to its archeological importance, the temple is preserved under the Archeological Survey of India under the Act 1958 on Ancient Monuments and Archaeological sites.



Shri Siddharoodha Swami Math

3.5 km

Hubli, the humble little town of Karnataka, houses the famous Siddharoodha Math (mutt) that holds a unique significance in Modern Hinduism. This famous tourist spot is **a renowned Hindu holy center**. It was built in the year 1929 where Sri Siddharoodha took Samadhi, to honor him



Railway Museum

1.6 km

The museum aims at preserving and portraying the glorious heritage of various branches of Railways and the displaying the gradual evolution of advanced systems in all spheres of Railway working.



Banashankari Temple Amargol

4.1 KM

The Banashankari Temple in Amargol is a **fine architectural marvel** and is **located near the Unkal Lake and the Chandramouleshwara Temple**. The temples built in this area in the 13th century exhibit northern influence. They *have the Nagara style incorporated into them. This temple is no exception.*



The Country Club Water World

15.KM

It has a water-based theme park located in the city of Hubli in Karnataka and never fails to draw visitors on a huge scale. It serves as a perfect holiday destination for all those seeking some relaxation away from the tedious schedules of the life.



Utsav Rock Garden 38 KM

Utsav Rock Garden is **an Indoor and Outdoor Sculpture Museum** located at Gotagodi, Shiggaon Taluk at Haveri district in **Karnataka**. The Garden consists of live-sculptures depicting the North Karnataka culture. Various murals, all which are hand-crafted are arranged in a prosaic manner.
